Subject: Raider 40HP Engine Training Accreditation

1. AFLCMC/WIS-Battlefield Airman Branch and ACC/A5/8RG conducted a validation/evaluation survey of Raider Outboards 40HP Multi-Fuel Outboard Engine Intermediate Maintenance & Repair Training Course (STRO-CONRT1-001), developed by Strategos Consulting LLC, on behalf of Raider Outboards, Inc. (OEM) for Guardian Angel (GA) Total Force accreditation.
2. Validation class was held on 20-24 Feb 2017 at Raider Outboards, Inc. (OEM) headquarters (Titusville, FL). Four GA representatives attended the training course (3 SME's from two RQS' & 1 PM from GA/SPO). Attendees provided positive feedback/evaluations, and highly recommended the class for future dive locker maintainers. Strategos Consulting LLC incorporated all GA attendees recommended changes into the syllabus, and is prepared for future GA Total Force training classes.
3. The above mentioned course incorporates the outboard motor, field service maintenance action, periodic maintenance, pre/post operational procedures and troubleshooting of the 40HP Raider Engine. The course can be taught at a variety of locations. An overall "excellent" rating was received on the end of course critiques from Maritime Engine SMEs.
4. The GA/SPO Maritime Program Manager and ACC/A5/8RG are coordinating/funding a Mobile Training Team (MTT) capability for Strategos Consulting LLC, on behalf of the engine OEM to train dive locker maintainers at GA RQS locations.
5. This letter documents the training provided to RQS' maritime maintainers meets organizational and depot level requirements to maintain the Raider 40HP Engines. Future Maritime Engine MTTs will constitute validated initial new equipment training requirement from requirement/acquisition teams at ACC & WPAFB. Any additional RQS desired training (sustainment) will be funding responsibility of unit.
